The top layer features genuine Black American walnut (Juglans nigra), known for its dark chocolate tones, refined grain, and natural luster. Each board reflects the quiet richness and depth that define true luxury interiors.

This wood reveals its finest character in patterned layouts such as herringbone and chevron, where the shifting light enhances the contrast and movement of its grain.

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Walnut grading criteria

WALNUT SELECT. Our Select Grade Black American Walnut is made exclusively from FAS (First and Seconds) lumber, the highest grade available. No lower grades of timber are ever used.

Each board is carefully chosen for its fine grain, rich tone, and natural depth of colour. Small, sound knots up to 20mm in diameter and occasional pin knots are permitted, adding gentle variation and authenticity.

Sapwood is visible in this selection, typically appearing along the edges or ends. Through a specific coating technique, we soften its contrast to bring calmness and balance to the overall tone, yet its complete absence is neither possible nor desired. It remains an authentic element of the species, adding depth and natural distinction to every board.



Notes:

Each plank is unique; colour and structure vary from board to board and between batches. UV exposure causes natural fading and colour change over time. Samples and photographs are only indicative and cannot represent the full floor surface.
